The Iowa Engineering and Land Surveying Examining Board (Board) and Lockwood Greene Engineers, Inc., an ~~Ohio~~ <sup>Massachusetts</sup> corporation (Respondent) stipulate to the following Cease and Desist Order pursuant to Iowa Code sections 542B.24 and .27 (1997):

1. Respondent is a Massachusetts corporation with offices in Cincinnati, Ohio.
2. Respondent prepared an engineering document entitled "Technical Risk Assessment" dated May 11, 1997, for a project located in Waterloo, Iowa, with an attached engineering document entitled "Area Electrical Classification." The documents were received by the project's Iowa owners, Hunt Wesson.
3. While Respondent has employed one or more professional engineers licensed under Iowa Code chapter 542B (1997), it did not have an Iowa licensed professional engineer in professional charge of all phases of the above project.
4. Professional engineering services may only be performed in Iowa by a professional engineer licensed in Iowa, pursuant to Iowa Code sections 542B.1 and 542B.27(1)(a)(1).

5. The Board is authorized by Iowa Code § 542B.24 to seek an injunction in district court enjoining any person who is not legally authorized to practice professional engineering in Iowa from engaging in such practice or advertising the availability of such services to the public. The Board is authorized to impose a civil penalty upon nonlicensees for the same violations, pursuant to Iowa Code section 542B.27 (1997).

6. It appears the Respondent has performed professional engineering services in Iowa involving the safeguarding of life, health and property.

7. The Board and Respondent have agreed to informally resolve the pending dispute. In the event this Stipulation is violated, it may be used as evidence against the party violating the agreement, although all parties understand that violations must be enforced by filing a petition in district court seeking an injunction, or imposing civil penalties through administrative procedures.

8. Respondent agrees it will not in the future engage in the practice of professional engineering in Iowa or represent to the public any ability or authority to do so in the State of Iowa unless at the time of the representation or practice it regularly employs, on other than an as-needed, occasional, or consulting basis, one or more professional engineers licensed in Iowa who directly control and personally supervise all professional engineering work performed by Respondent, its successors or assigns.

9. This Stipulation is a public record pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 22 and will be provided to the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying.
