The Iowa Engineering and Land Surveying Examining Board (Board), Ms. Carol E. Wilson (Wilson), Mr. Richard T. Kavanaugh (Kavanaugh), and CHEM-ECO Engineers, inc. (CHEM-ECO) stipulate to the following Cease and Desist Order pursuant to Iowa Code § 542B.24 (1993):

- 1. Wilson and Kavanaugh are residents of Olin, Iowa. Wilson is the sole owner and director of CHEM-ECO, an Iowa corporation.
- 2. Wilson and Kavanaugh are not currently professional engineers registered under Iowa Code chapter 542B (1993), and CHEM-ECO does not have a professional engineer on staff or a principal who is a professional engineer.
- 3. The Board is authorized by Iowa Code § 542B.24 to seek an injunction in district court enjoining any person who is not legally authorized to practice professional engineering in Iowa from engaging in such practice, or from using any designation in connection with the person's name tending to imply or designate the person as a professional engineer.
- 4. The Board, Wilson, Kavanaugh, and CHEM-ECO have agreed to informally resolve a pending dispute concerning the marketing practices of Wilson, Kavanaugh, and CHEM-ECO. In the event this

Stipulation is violated, it may be used as evidence against the party violating the agreement, although all parties understand that violations must be enforced by filing a petition in district court seeking an injunction.

- 5. Wilson agrees that she will not in the future engage in the practice of engineering or represent to the public any ability or authority to do so without a current registration to practice. Wilson will cease referring to herself as a "Chemical Engineer" and will cease using any other designation in connection with her name tending to imply or designate her as a professional engineer.
- 6. Kavanaugh agrees that he will not in the future engage in the practice of engineering or represent to the public any ability or authority to do so without a current registration to practice. Kavanaugh will cease referring to himself as a "Civil Engineer" and will cease using any other designation in connection with his name tending to imply or designate him as a professional engineer.
- 7. that it will not CHEM-ECO agrees in the represent to the public any ability or authority to engage in the engineering unless, οf at the time representation, it is owned or managed by, or regularly employs, on other than an as-needed, occasional, or consulting basis, one or more registered professional engineers who directly control and personally supervise all professional engineering work it performs.
