STIPULATION

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Iowa Accountancy Examining Board that Charles F. Scott was convicted of the crimes of Assault with Intent to Cause Serious Injury and Trespass in violation of Section 708.1 and 708.2(1) of the 1985 Code of Iowa in the Iowa District Court of Wapello County; and

WHEREAS, Charles F. Scott was given opportunity to appear voluntarily with legal counsel before the Board's Committee on Ethics and Enforcement to orally present additional data, views, and comments at an informal conference held on July 8, 1987; and

WHEREAS, Charles F. Scott with full knowledge of the investigation, its potential legal consequences, the right to counsel, and the right to formal adjudicatory proceedings under Iowa Code Section 116.23, did appear voluntarily;


NOW THEREFORE, the Iowa Accountancy Examining Board and Charles . Scott do hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

- 1. Charles F. Scott admits the jurisdiction of the Iowa Accountancy Examining Board over this action.
- 2. Charles F. Scott shall pay a fine of \$1000.00 on or before November 15, 1987.
- 3. Charles F. Scott is placed on probation for a period of one year from the date of this stipulation.
 - 4. The Iowa Accountancy Examining Board reserves the right to call an informal conference at the end of the one year probation to review this matter and extend the probation.
 - 5. Failure to execute the provisions of the Stipulation shall result in the Board setting a date for a formal hearing for failure to comply with an order of the Board pursuant to Iowa Code Section 258A.3(2)(a).
 - 6. This agreement shall constitute the entire agreement of the parties hereto and is intended to be a final disposition of all matters which are the subject of this stipulation. Satisfactory completion of the terms of this stipulation shall be considered final disposition of this matter and no other proceedings shall be instituted in this latter.

7. This stiuplation is voluntarily entered into by Charles F. Scott and Charles F. Scott fully realizes the legal consequences of this stipulation.
