A. Statement of Charges

1. The Iowa Architectural Examining Board ("Board") has jurisdiction of this disciplinary matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 17A, 272C, and 544A(2009).
2. Respondent was issued Iowa registration number 062336 on the 5th day of March, 2009. The registration currently is active and will next expire on the 30th day of June, 2009.
3. Respondent is a registered architect in the state of Iowa. During the process of making application for registration to the state of Iowa, Respondent failed to disclose that he had been disciplined by the South Carolina Board of Architectural Examiners.
6. Following investigation, the Board charges Respondent with making a materially false statement or deliberately failing to disclose a material fact requested in connection with an application for registration. Iowa Code section 272C10(1) and IAC 193B-4.1(4)"d."
7. The Board and Respondent have agreed to fully resolve these charges through the following Consent Order, rather than proceed to contested case hearing.

B. Settlement Agreement and Consent Order

8. Respondent has a right to a hearing on the charges, but waives his right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to seek judicial review, by freely and voluntarily entering into this Order. This Consent Order constitutes discipline against the Respondent, and is the final agency order in the contested case, pursuant to Iowa Code section 17A.10 and 193 Iowa Administrative Code 7.4.

9. Respondent agrees the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board and may have ex parte communications with the Board while presenting it.

10. This Order shall be part of the permanent record of Respondent and shall be considered by the Board in determining the nature and severity of any future disciplinary action to be imposed in the event of any future violations.

11. This Combined Statement of Charges and Consent Order is a public record available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapter 22 (2007).

12. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order shall be grounds for further disciplinary action pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.3(2)(a) (2007). However, no action may be taken against Respondent for violations of these provisions without a hearing, or waiver of hearing.

13. This Order is subject to approval of the Board:

(a) If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect on either party, and it shall not be admissible for any purpose in further proceedings in this matter.

(b) If the Board approves this Order, it shall fully dispose of all issues in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

A. Reprimand

Respondent is reprimanded for failure to disclose that he had been disciplined by the South Carolina Board of Architectural Examiners on his application for registration in the state of Iowa.

B. Remedial Orders


Respondent shall complete the National Council of Architecture Registration Boards (NCARB) continuing education monograph titled *Professional Conduct*. Evidence of completion of the monograph shall be sent to the board no later than June 30, 2009. Continuing education hours for completion of this course shall not be count toward renewal of Respondent's Iowa registration.

C. Future Compliance

Respondent shall in the future adhere to all statutes and administrative rules in the practice of architecture.


