COMBINED STATEMENT OF  
CHARGES AND CONSENT ORDER  
IN DISCIPLINARY CASE

A. Statement of Charges

1. The Iowa Architectural Examining Board ("Board") has jurisdiction of this disciplinary matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 17A, 272C, and 544A (2005).
2. Respondent was issued Iowa registration number 03549 on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1995. The registration is active and will next expire on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2009.
3. Respondent submitted an application for renewal of registration on July 5, 2007 reporting a total 24 hours of Continuing Professional Education all of which were public protection subjects, however only four (4) hours were earned during the biennial renewal reporting period July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2007. Twenty-four (24) hours with sixteen (16) in public protection subjects are required for the outlined period in accordance with 193B—3.2(1) IAC, making the Respondent 20 hours (12 of which should be public protection subjects) deficient in the required number of hours.
4. Following investigation, the Board charges Respondent with failure to comply with continuing education requirements in violation of 193B—3.1(2) IAC.
5. The Board and Respondent have agreed to fully resolve these charges through the following Consent Order, rather than proceed to contested case hearing.

B. Settlement Agreement and Consent Order

8. Respondent has a right to a hearing on the charges, but waives his right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to seek judicial review, by freely and voluntarily entering into this Order. This Consent Order constitutes discipline against the Respondent, and

is the final agency order in the contested case, pursuant to Iowa Code section 17A.10 and 193 Iowa Administrative Code 7.4.

9. Respondent agrees the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board and may have ex parte communications with the Board while presenting it.

10. This Order shall be part of the permanent record of Respondent and shall be considered by the Board in determining the nature and severity of any future disciplinary action to be imposed in the event of any future violations.

11. This Combined Statement of Charges and Consent Order is a public record available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapter 22 (2005).

12. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order shall be grounds for further disciplinary action pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.3(2)(a) (2005). However, no action may be taken against Respondent for violations of these provisions without a hearing, or waiver of hearing.

13. This Order is subject to approval of the Board:

(a) If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect on either party, and it shall not be admissible for any purpose in further proceedings in this matter.

(b) If the Board approves this Order, it shall fully dispose of all issues in this case.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

A. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$100 within thirty days of receipt of this executed document.

B. Respondent shall complete a total of 40 hours of continuing education (16 hours shall be in public protection subjects) by September 30, 2007.

C. Documentation of completion of the education shall be submitted to the Board office on or before October 31, 2007. These hours may include the hours previously reported on the reporting form earned after July, 1 2007, but none of the 40 hours required shall apply to the next renewal reporting period.

D. Respondent shall earned an additional 24 hours (16 in public protection subjects) prior to June 30, 2009 as required to renew his registration through June 30, 2011.

E. Respondent shall in the future adhere to all statutes and administrative rules in the practice of architecture.
