This includes treating patients at an Iowa practice location, as well as follow-up care that may occur telephonically, and treating patients located in Iowa using telehealth. An ARNP with a patient who resides in another state is strongly encouraged to query the patient's state of residence, if available, or to query that state's PMP, if registered to do so. Any ARNP who is in a border-state community is strongly encouraged to check the box to query the border state if that option is available.

An ARNP can delegate the PMP query to another licensed or registered individual(s). Each delegate must have their own log-in credentials with the PMP.
