A district court had affirmed the Board's decision and Leach appealed to the lowa Court of Appeals. AAG Register informed the Board that the lowa Court of Appeals issued an opinion that morning affirming the Board's decision. The licensee has 30 days to seek further review by the lowa Supreme Court.
