CONFERENCE CALL MINUTES February 5, 2020 3:30 p.m.

This electronic meeting of the Iowa Board of Nursing was held in accordance with Iowa Code section 21.8. The Code states that a governmental body may conduct a meeting by electronic means only if circumstances are such that a meeting in person is impossible or impractical and access is provided to the public. An in-person meeting of the Board to handle this limited agenda was impractical due to the schedules of the Board members and the resources of the Board. On a motion by BJ Hoffman, the Board voted to adopt the agenda.

Kathy Weinberg, Executive Director, reminded the Board Members the next Conference Call is March 11, 2020 and the next Board meeting is April 8-10, 2020 to let her know if anyone will be absent. She reported that individuals have applied for the Board Member positions and the new Board Members should be announced March 1^{st,} 2020.

Update on Federal Forfeiture of Nursing Licenses: AAG Register informed the Board of a recent license forfeiture by the United States. Following a criminal conviction, the federal government ordered the nurse-defendant to forfeit his nursing license to the federal government. The nurse's attorney disputed whether the federal government had the authority to forfeit a state-issued license, but the federal judge held that the Board is free to issue the nurse a new license in the future. AAG Register stated that as long as the license is forfeited, the Board cannot reinstate that license. AAG Register stated at this time the Board does not need to take any action and that AAG Register will be working with Board staff to come up with a procedure on how to classify and track forfeited licenses. Investigator Holsapple questioned if there was any way to notify the Board when the Federal Government takes ownership of a license. AAG stated we could ask the Federal Government to notify the Board when this occurs, but they don't have to tell us. She also stated the information is available through PACER, which she can access.
