



National APRN Practice & Pandemic Survey

The purposes of this study are to:

1. determine the impact of practice barriers and restrictions on providing patient care and on your APRN practice, and
2. understand the effect of the COVID-19 pandemic on patient care and on your APRN practice.

Since the COVID-19 pandemic, a number of states enacted waivers of restrictions on advanced practice registered nurse (APRN) practice. To gather as much information as possible about the current situation, we will be seeking your participation in a short survey.

The results will be anonymous and collated through the use of a web-based Research Electronic Data Capture (REDCap) survey, using a HIPAA compliant secure platform. Participation is voluntary, and data will be reported in aggregate. Institutional Review Board review has been secured from Vanderbilt University.

The survey coordinating center is Vanderbilt University School of Nursing along with the University of Tennessee Knoxville and University of Tennessee Health Sciences Center, Memphis TN.
