Now on this 9th day of September 2019, the Iowa Real Estate Commission [Commission] makes the following findings:

1. Following its receipt of a "Certificate of Noncompliance" from the Iowa Department of Human Services issued pursuant to Iowa Code section 252J.7, the Commission served upon the Respondent a "Notice of Intent to Suspend License" [Notice] on July 2, 2019.

2. The above-referenced Notice provided that the Respondent's real estate salesperson license would be suspended if the Commission did not receive a "Withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance" from the Iowa Department of Human Services within 60 days.


3. As of the date of this Order, the Commission has not received a withdrawal of the certificate of noncompliance; nor has the Commission received a court order or other evidence that the Respondent timely filed a judicial review action under Iowa Code section 252J.9 challenging the suspension of his license.

4. Because more than 60 days has elapsed since service of the above-referenced Notice was made upon the Respondent, the Commission is accordingly required to suspend the Respondent's license.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED, PURSUANT TO IOWA CODE SECTIONS 252J.7 AND 252J.8, THAT:

1. The Iowa Real Estate Commission ("Commission") intends to suspend your **ACTIVE** real estate license ("license") due to the Commission's receipt of the attached certificate of noncompliance from the Child Support Recovery Unit ("Unit").
2. You must contact the Unit at the address or phone number in the attached certificate(s) to schedule a conference or otherwise obtain a withdrawal of the certificate(s) of noncompliance.
3. Unless the Unit furnishes a withdrawal of the certificate(s) of noncompliance to the Commission before September 2, 2019, your **ACTIVE** license with the Commission will be suspended.
4. Pursuant to 193 IAC 8.1(2), the effective date of the denial of the issuance or renewal of a license, as specified in the notice required by Iowa Code section 252J.8, shall be 60 days following service of the notice upon the licensee or applicant.
5. Pursuant to 193E IAC 8.1(4) you are required to keep the Commission informed of all court actions and all actions taken by the Unit by providing copies to the Commission within seven days of filing or issuance, of all applications filed with the district court pursuant to Iowa Code section 252J.9, all court orders entered in such actions, and withdrawals of certificates of noncompliance by the Unit.

6. You do not have a right to hearing before the Commission, but you do have the right to contest this Notice by requesting a court hearing pursuant to Iowa Code section 252J.9, within thirty days of service of this Notice.

TAKE NOTICE AND GOVERN YOURSELF ACCORDINGLY.
