## ACCEPTANCE OF THE BOARD OF NURSING ANNUAL REPORT

Laura Hudson, Associate Director, discussed the draft of the annual report for acceptance by the Board members. Education and employment statistics were briefly reviewed.

On the motion by Kathryn Dolter seconded by Nancy Kramer, acceptance of the 2019-2020 Annual Report was approved.

# DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF REQUIRING BASIC CARDIAC LIFE SUPPORT AS A LICENSURE REQUIREMENT AND AWARDING CE CREDIT

Director Weinberg facilitated a discussion with Board members regarding consideration of requiring Basic Cardiac Life Support as a requirement for licensure and awarding continuing education credit for completion. Ms. Weinberg reviewed the documents provided to the Board members regarding current licensing practices and procedures regarding Basic Cardiac Life Support from other state nursing boards as well as other lowa health boards. The Board members discussed points both for and against the requirement.

Board member Goettsch expressed his feelings concerning the awarding of Continuing Education (CE) to nurses, he felt that it was education which increased the nurse's knowledge due to the fact that the technique and information provided every two years did change and was not considered basic education.

Board member Dolter, Kramer and Beltz expressed opinions that Basic Life Support was in fact basic education and did not provide any advanced learning for the nurse. It is a requirement for nursing programs and an employment requirement. Dr. Dolter did point out that CE is awarded for course work that is above that which is taught in basic education such as advanced lifesaving courses.

After discussion, the Board members took no action.
