

Electronic Meeting: On March 19, 2020 Governor Reynolds issued a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency, wherein she temporarily suspended the regulatory provisions of Iowa Code section 21.8 "Electronic Meetings" to the extent the statute prevented a governmental body from holding a meeting by electronic means. Consistent with this Proclamation, conference call instructions for members of the public to participate in the open session portion of the meeting are as follows:

- 1. At the specified time, dial the Reservations Plus dial-in number (1-866-685-1580).
- 2. When prompted, enter the conference code (5152814822) followed by #.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Any person who has submitted material for the agenda will be given an opportunity to address the Board during that particular agenda item. A member of the public wishing to address the Board regarding a particular agenda item should raise a hand during that agenda item to be recognized. Acknowledgment and an opportunity to speak will be at the discretion of the Board chairperson.

During the initial "Public Comment" period, members of the public will have the opportunity to speak for up to two minutes regarding any item not on the agenda, or regarding any agenda item if the person is unable to be present for the discussion of the particular agenda item.

CLOSED SESSIONS

Portions of the meeting may be held in closed session, as indicated on the agenda. Final actions will be taken in open session.

In accordance with Iowa Code section 272C.6, disciplinary hearings may be held in open or closed session, at the discretion of the licensee. License application denial hearings will be held in open session. When multiple hearings are scheduled for the same time, the hearings may be held in a different order than listed on the agenda. Board deliberation after each hearing is held in closed session pursuant to Iowa Code section 21.5(1)(f), to discuss the decision to be rendered in a contested case conducted according to the provisions of chapter 17A.

Agenda items listed under Closed Session will be handled before and after the scheduled hearings, after the conclusion of the open session agenda items.
