TO BECOME AN ASSOCIATE APPRAISER (KNOWN IN SOME STATES AS A TRAINEE)

Prerequisites

- 75 hours of qualifying courses approved by the Appraiser Qualifications Board (AQB) (refer to resource "AQB Approved Courses" below)
 - 30 Hour Basic Appraisal Principles
 - 30 Hour Basic Appraisal Procedures
 - 15 Hour USPAP Course
- Identify a supervisor
- Take the Supervisor/Associate Course

Both the associate and the Supervisor must take this course (refer to the board's website for approved courses)

• Complete the online application titled, "General-Background Packet Request" and submit the state and federal waiver along with the completed fingerprint cards and applicable fee to the Board's office

While an applicant may use the FBI fingerprint cards provided by an authorized finger printer location, they must still complete the online application and submit the federal and state waiver forms.

• Complete the online application titled, "Associate Appraiser Registration" and submit it along with the applicable fee to the Board office.
