Explain why following the rule would pose an undue hardship:	Northwind Pharmaceuticals, LLC has been VAWD accredited from 2007 – 2019 at which time a change of location had resulted in a new application for VAWD. Northwind Pharmaceuticals is actively engaged with NABP for VAWD accreditation. Northwind Pharmaceuticals has also been licensed in the state of lowa since 01/01/1998. The imposed rule would prevent Northwind Pharmaceuticals from shipping the medications to the entities to provide to the patients who require them.
Explain how waiving the rule may impact other people:	Waiving the VAWD requirement temporarily to provide the additional time for Northwind Pharmaceuticals to complete the VAWD accreditation process [which is on hold due to the COVID- 19 National Emergency] which will ensure the patients are not impacted by the disruption in the

Explain how the rule is intended to protect the public health, safety, or welfare:	The VAWD accreditation requirement is intended to ensure the every Wholesale Distributor maintains strict controls to protect the public health and well-being of the end user. The fact that Northwind Pharmaceuticals has been accredited for over ten years and been providing medications to customers in Iowa for over twenty years demonstrates Northwind Pharmaceutical's commitment to protecting the public health.

E: NABP Program Update in Response to COVID-19 Epidemic

As COVID-19 continues to spread throughout the United States, NABP has continued to monitor the virus' impact on patients, the Association's member boards, customers and staff.

Accreditation Customers:

A careful review of entities holding accreditation through NABP provides assurance that the extension of the current accreditation is possible and in the best interest of patient care. All entities currently holding accreditation with NABP and undergoing reaccreditation or holds an accreditation that will expire prior to June 1, 2020 will have their accreditation automatically extended for three months pursuant to the following conditions:

- NABP is temporarily suspending all accreditation survey activity.
- Any accredited entity that is currently undergoing reaccreditation or whose accreditation will expire prior to June 1, 2020, will need to
 have submitted their reaccreditation materials, submit the required fee to NABP, and execute an attestation. The attestation will
 acknowledge further that should NABP find evidence to the contrary the entity may be subject to immediate suspension or revocation of
 its accreditation.
- NABP will continue to process all new program applications up until the point that a survey is required. At which time, an assessment will be made of whether or not an on-site survey should or can be completed.
- NABP will communicate the status of our survey operations to all states and relevant networks/3rd parties.

Inspection Customers:

- NABP is temporarily suspending all inspection activity.
- NABP will continue to process all new program applications up until the point that an inspection is required. At which time, an assessment will be made of whether or not an on-site inspection should or can be completed.
- NABP will communicate the status of our inspection operations to all states and relevant networks/3rd parties.

NABP will continue to monitor the status of COVID-19 and will keep all parties apprised of any changes to the status of our survey and inspection operations. To that end, we will send out regular, formal updates. We appreciate your patience during this challenging time and hope that collectively, by taking these measures together, we can all accelerate the return to normalcy.

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
