Program Update: Rhonda and Michele will attend the National Organization of Alternative to Discipline Program (NOAP) Conference, May 16-19, 2022. The conference is held in Albuquerque, New Mexico. NOAP was established to promote public safety by developing alternatives to licensure discipline, promoting safe practice and retention through

rehabilitation, monitoring, research education and standardization of programs; and to collaborate with other professional and consumers to achieve those outcomes. Attending NOAP assists INAP to establish best practices for the prevention, identification, and monitoring of health professionals with substance use disorders.

INAP Committee: The INAPC met on 03/08/2022 for the quarterly meeting. The INAPC reviewed four INAP non-appearance cases and reviewed seven participant appearances at the meeting. The next quarterly meeting is 06/07/2022 and will be in-person at IBON.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Financial Report

David Brunk discussed the Financial Report. In response to a question by Gordon Goettsch, Director Weinberg explained that AMANDA 6 is expiring and upgrading to AMANDA 7 is a necessary expense.

Legislation

Legislation from the Board of Pharmacy, which would allow RNs to administer vaccines in a pharmacy without first obtaining a pharmacy technician registration, remains pending in the legislature. HF2547, which relates to midwives, remains pending in the Senate. SF487, which is a licensure bill requiring five-year reports to the legislature among other justification requirements, was again introduced and remains pending. Legislation was also introduced, and is expected to pass, that will merge IDPH and DHS into one department: DHHS. In response to a question from Gordon Goettsch, Director Weinberg explained it will affect licensing boards like IBON, including altering the Board's place in the organizational chart. The affect on the Board's core functions remains unclear. AAG Register stated there is currently a statute that preserves the Board's core functions, like discipline and rulemaking, in Chapter 135.

Staff

The Board currently has three open staff positions: Licensing Clerk Specialist, Associate Director of Continuing Education, and Workforce and Secretary 3. All staff working hard to fill the duties. In response to a question from Gordon Goettsch, asked about who is doing the provider work? Kathy Weinberg stated current staff is taking on extra duties to cover the vacant positions.
