

Pursuant to <u>lowa Administrative Code (IAC) 80.45A</u>, beginning 01/01/2022, all in-state lodging providers must complete the Department of Public Safety's Human Trafficking Prevention Training certification to receive public funds for State employee lodging, conferences, meeting, banquets, or any state-funded event. If a lodging provider is not certified, public funds cannot be used for travel reimbursement or any other expense.

Per the Department of Administrative Services' State Accounting Enterprise policy 210.205 (in part): Employees shall provide a screen shot of the search for the lodging provider showing it as a certified location with the request for reimbursement.

- Prior to reserving a lodging establishment for overnight travel, go to the Stop Human Trafficking website at https://stophtiowa.org/certified-locations. You may search for a lodging by either zooming-in on the map, or by entering search terms in the fields.
- To search by using the map, hold down <u>Ctrl</u> while scrolling, and click on the map pin. Take a screenshot of the certification and attach it to your Expense Report in Workday.



3. To search by using the search fields, enter the appropriate information in the field(s), and click **Apply**. Take a screenshot of the certification and attach it to your Expense Report in Workday.
