PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, identifying hazards early, evaluating risks, and removing or controlling hazards before they cause harm are essential to preventing workplace injuries and illnesses; and

WHEREAS, all employees play a vital role in creating safe workplaces by being actively involved, looking out for one another, and promoting safe behaviors and conditions; and

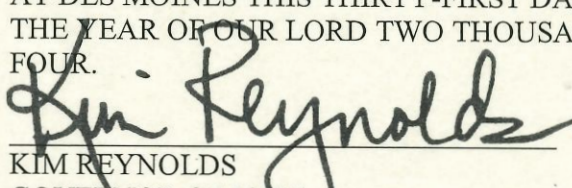

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kim Reynolds, Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim the week of August 10-14, 2026, as:

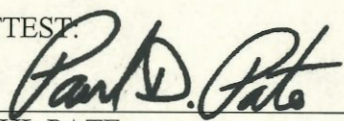
